
## **Garfinkel Guide**



## **INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE**

- Choose the proper quadrant on the Guide. All four quadrants are on each Guide.
- 2. Superimpose the laser-etched teeth of the Guide on the edentulous ridge using any remaining natural dentition as an additional orientation for the Guide.

**4.** Use Guide after each implant is placed to verify alignment and parallelism.







## **GUIDE POSITIONING BY QUADRANT**

**MAXILLARY RIGHT SIDE:** Mirror is placed palatal to the ridge and the operator looks from the facial side.

**MAXILLARY LEFT SIDE:** Mirror retracts the cheek and the operator views from the palatal side.

**MANDIBULAR RIGHT SIDE:** Operator views from the facial side and the mirror retracts the tongue.

**MANDIBULAR LEFT SIDE:** Mirror retracts the cheek and operator views from the lingual side.

## **CLEANING/STERILIZING INSTRUCTIONS**

Garfinkel Guides are coated with rhodium, a durable metallic finish. Care should be taken to ensure both proper cleaning and longevity.

The recommended method for cleaning is steam autoclaving using the following procedure:

- 1. Hand wash the mirrors with clean gauze and germicidal soap containing 2% chlorhexide.
- 2. Dry the Guide using gauze sponges or a Zeza Multi-Purpose Surgical Towel. Wrap the Guides in a surgical towel taking care to separate them with layers of towel.
- 3. Place in a steam autoclave unit and process.

Chemical sterilants — We do not recommend the use of chemical or cold sterilants. These chemicals may leave permanent streaks on the surface of the Guide.
